

Dear Colleagues,

The Mississauga Halton Central West (MHCW) Regional Cancer Program (RCP) is seeking expressions of interest for the position of Regional Primary Care Lead (RPCL) Prevention and Cancer Screening, Central West (CW). The RPCL has direct accountability to the Regional Vice President (RVP) of Cancer Services and indirect accountability to the Regional Director, Regional Cancer Program, and Ontario Health (OH) Cancer Care Ontario (CCO) Provincial Lead, Primary Care, Prevention and Cancer Screening.

The role of the RPCL is to support primary care engagement and collaboration in the OH(CCO) Prevention and Cancer Screening (CS) portfolio and associated initiatives. The work also includes strategic advisory activities at local and provincial levels to advance OH(CCO) prevention and cancer screening priorities.

The RPCL will be a key partner in the Regional Cancer Program and the Primary Care portfolio in providing advice and supporting the primary care goal to support cancer prevention and screening initiatives and play an active role in increasing the percentage of eligible people who get screened regularly and the percentage of people who have timely and appropriate follow-up of abnormal results. Working closely with the RPCL in Mississauga Halton and with the Cancer Screening Leads for the MHCW region, the RPCL for Central West will be actively engaged to support efforts to raise both public and healthcare provider awareness of the importance of cancer screening and prevention efforts.

The RPCL engages and collaborates with primary care providers both provincially and regionally to implement the Ontario Cancer Plan (OCP). This role is essential to ensuring successful engagement and collaboration across the diversity of primary care contexts and teams. The RPCL will fulfill a critical role in improving quality, safety, equity, and accessibility of appropriate care from cancer screening to diagnosis and appropriate management of screening-related abnormalities. The RPCL provides the clinical leadership needed to build, foster, and maintain robust regional engagement with the primary care community. As such, regular attendance at scheduled RCP and provincial primary care meetings is of critical importance in supporting the regional needs and ensuring optimal representation to support and further the quality agenda for the region and the province.
